## **UK – Republic of Korea Reciprocal Recognition of Equivalence for Organics**

Thank you for your letter dated 22 November 2024 confirming that MAFRA will extend recognition of the UK's organic system for a further four years until 31 December 2028 under Article 25 of the Act on the Promotion of Environment-friendly Agriculture and Fisheries and the Management of and Support for Organic Foods of Korea.

We look forward to continuing our working relationship with MAFRA during the next four years. Towards the end of this four years period, we will review together whether a further extension to our arrangement is needed or a new arrangement is to be agreed.
